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SUMMARY

hasn't developed yet or they may not have the information because they don't yet have that life experience or they may have lack of worth and they may have anxiety about it therefore they behave in a particular way so always when you don't understand someone's Behavior give them benefit of doubt maybe they are missing the skill because of their emotional brain development maybe they are missing the information because of
