- *Start with simple books that use easy language to build confidence.*

- *Visit bookstores and libraries monthly, allowing children to choose their own books.*
- *Incorporate audiobooks for auditory learners, providing an alternative way to engage with stories.*

five simple ways to make your child read more readers are leaders so make sure you follow these five steps to raise a little leader at home one start with simple books with easy language exposing them to tough books can make them feel that reading is very tough two create a cozy quiet reading space with easy access to a variety of books magazines and age appropriate reading material three read together my son and I spent 20 to 30 minutes every day reading

together we sometimes also discuss the books that we read we have been doing this since he was 2 years of age four visit book shops and libraries together can do this at least once a month let your child pick and read a book of their choice and five use audio books some children are auditory Learners and learn better by listening to books you can let your child listen to books on Audible save this video and share with someone

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
