dark chocolate does not have any milk at all a gently added time you can put as much melted chocolate so you reach the consistency that you like i like my hot chocolate really really

and the very important thing to note actually is when you mix chocolate with a liquid the first thing is that it mixes very well and then it starts to separate so actually you start seeing the little dots which is the crystal separating but don't have it keep on whisking it and you'll be shocked it gets stunning and silly
