make if you've tried the rocky making kids and their Dino kids then you're sure to love this one what we really love about quest blocks is that it's very very portable it challenges you and you get hooked on to it so you want to keep trying keep trying until you get it right the end of the game is obviously to get the other piece out and it has three different levels easy medium and hard while they say that it is for

children and two adults I would say you could start as young as maybe five and a half or six because the my daughter chowder and she's six and she absolutely loves it and the easy is quite easy for her so I think you can start a little younger but don't be surprised if you are also tempted to play alongside her and even after she is packed it up you are still trying to figure out and trying to get to the difficult level

then you know trying to play by yourself but it's a great game to travel with we're going to take you how to play through this right now so this is what your game comes with you have a unblock West panel here you have three different cards so this is your easy which is right here front this is your front and this is your back okay then you have medium which is right here and this is the hard one

now what we have already done here is we have kept this problem ready here and I'm going to show you how you can solve that so when you need to push the problem into the child you put these pieces right in and then all you need to do is just unlock this like this and block it like this and they need to get the beasts out if you see it then here there is a little opening from whether yellow

piece will come out so here we're trying to solve this and I hope we get it quite soon as we've got this here we slightest and here you go you've got it and this actually takes you about two or three minutes and what's interesting is that as the kids you know get familiar with it and they get familiar with the sequences you would realize that maybe time is a better way to push them to do it faster than what you would actually

want them to do so I think it's a great game very very portable and it's so easy to carry these cars like just bundle them up then you're going to just put them in a pouch and there you go so I think this game I imagine make is quite cool and sometimes you will find yourself playing and struggling to finish this too so have fun and don't forget to subscribe to our YouTube channel and make sure you share this
